Financial technology is an emerging field of innovation and entrepreneurship in the MENA region, where the number of fintech startups in the region more than doubled between 2013 and 2015— increasing from 46 to 105. In the age of increased internet connectivity and smartphone penetration, fintech can extend much-needed financial services, like electronic payments, micro-insurance and remittances, to people traditional banks have struggled to reach. Fintech can also unlock new funding avenues for small and growing businesses, which often battle to access finance –and meet stringent reporting and compliance requirements– in a risk-averse banking sector.

Yet, the region's ecosystem is still disconnected. How can we collaborate to create a market big enough for fintech to grow and well mature with the right talent, demand and funding capabilities.
